DOC DÃO white 2014 **CASA AMÉRICO ENCRUZADO**

HISTORY The brand “Casa Américo” was established by the hands of Américo Seabra , father, who had the dream of producing wine is homeland, Vila Nova de Tazém . The project was followed by the hands of his sons who recovered the property of the century XVIII and built a new winery.

“Casa Américo” now has 100 ha of vineyards, with the oldest ranging over 100 years. Composed by the noble grape varieties from the Dão region, the several parcels are planted in granite soil, between 500 and 600m altitude. The sub-region where they are located, Serra da Estrela, is one of the most important terroirs of Dão Region well known by its natural freshness and a unique elegance.

VINEYARDS These grapes are from two plots located in the village of Gouveia. The vines are 40 years old with yields around 4ton/ha, altitude of 600m high and only the best grapes are selected to the final blend.

VINIFICATION Vindima manual. Prensagem com desengace total, com maceração pelicular durante 10h a uma temperatura de 12°C. Iniciou a fermentação em pequenos depósitos inox a temperatura controlada de 16°C e terminou a fermentação em barricas de carvalho francês onde permaneceu durante 3 meses, com batonnage. Permanece um mínimo de 5 meses em garrafa antes de sair para o mercado.

TASTING NOTES Cor amarelo pálida com laivos esverdeados. Aroma delicado com notas de frutos de polpa branca e casca de citrinos. Na boca é cremoso, com uma bela acidez e um final longo e mineral.
